## OVERVIEW

### 2014 Fall Programs—WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

**FIRST NIGHT—August 20**—Come rally around our first night of fall programs.

**FIRST NIGHT at FIRST** will be held on **Wednesday, August 20th**, beginning with a meal served 5:30-6:20 p.m., prepared by Wilson Team #7. Wednesday nights are wonderful at First Presbyterian, so come out for an adventure in learning for all ages as our Worshipful Wednesday resumes with “First Night.”

To wrap up this special evening, ice cream will be served at 7:15 p.m.

#### **TRACK 1:**

**Beth Moore: *Jesus the One and Only***: an in-depth, 11-week study of the life of Christ based on the Book of Luke. The study is interactive and includes personal, daily assignments and weekly group sessions during which you will view Beth Moore’s DVD lectures, taped on location in Jerusalem and the places where Jesus walked. Women’s study. Weekly video and participant’s guide (\$15). 8 weeks (August 27-November 19.)

#### **TRACK 2:**

**“CREATIVE ARTS-OUR HEARTS IN OUR HANDS”**- a variety of creative arts programs offered for participants to express their gifts and/or desires through the use of their hands. You only need the interest in the subject matter for these sessions—no need to think you must have necessary “talents”.

**“Basic Printmaking”**-Jennifer Willard, Director of Community School of the Arts, will give hands-on instruction in the art of printmaking. Participants will manipulate water-soluble inks and utilize the Community School of the

Arts printing press to create one-of-a-kind monoprints. Follow her to express talents even you didn’t know you had. (2 sessions-August 27 & September 3).

**\*Basics of Basket Weaving**-Mary Wilson will demonstrate the basics of basket weaving as participants make a napkin basket. Beginning with a 7 1/2 inch drill board, you will learn to use round and flat reed to do twill and over/under weave patterns as well as rim and lash to finish the top of the basket. After three sessions, you will have a completed basket. (3 sessions-September 10, 17 and 24). **Class size limited to 12—MUST REGISTER BY CALLING CHURCH OFFICE (fee of approximately \$15 for materials).**

**\*The Art of Woodcarving**-Gary Anderson will make you feel like a pro with his many talents as a woodcarver. He will have participants care and old world Santa. This is a good beginner project and can be completed in the four sessions planned. Gary will provide the carving blanks, knives, and safety gloves. **Class is limited to 12—MUST REGISTER BY CALLING CHURCH OFFICE.**  
(4 sessions-October 1, 8, 15, and 22)

#### **TRACK 3:**

**Officer Training:** William Pender will lead the newly elected officers in training as they prepare to begin service in January, 2015. (12 sessions (August 27-November 19.)

#### **TRUNK OR TREAT**

**October 29:** No regular programs will be offered because this will be an evening of food, celebration and fellowship with lots of treats—just lots of FUN! Meal will be served at 6:00 instead of 5:30pm.
