

Construction Update

With all of the closures in and around the church, please pay attention to the signs that warn us not to enter the affected areas. These signs have been installed to maintain our safety, so do not go into any of these areas.

There are two ways to better understand what is happening with the renovation project at FPC: (1) walk around the outside of the church and see the demolition that has taken place on State Street and on Church Avenue and (2) view the videos and photographs taken by the Communications Committee on the Church's website at www.fpcknox.org. The connector between the Sanctuary and the Chapel is completely removed revealing the beautiful exterior of the south educational wing that was built in the 1920's (State Street view) and the steps and the "porch" have been removed from the Church Avenue entrance and you are able to see where the new atrium will be located. Our beautiful stained glass windows are not fully open with not obstruction from the connector.

Reminder:

Currently, there are two ways to enter the sanctuary, either through the front doors or through the north door (the door near the lectern). The door near the lectern is also the way to exit the sanctuary to the nearest restrooms located on the balcony above Fellowship Hall. Please remember that all children elementary age and younger must be accompanied by an adult when leaving the sanctuary. This is a safety issue, and it is very important that we keep our children safe.

We appreciate how cooperative everyone has been during this phase of the renovation, and we realize that there will be more changes to come.
