

Construction Update (2015-11-15)

With all of the closures in and around the church, please pay attention to the signs that warn us not to enter the affected areas. These signs have been installed to maintain our safety, so do not go into any of these areas.

For several Sundays the audio system in the sanctuary has not been working properly, and last Sunday it quit working altogether. Broadway Sound is working with our contractor and our electrical subcontractor to remedy the issue as soon as possible. A portion of the new equipment that will be used in the sanctuary after the renovation will soon be installed to provide amplification during the church services. As the videos of the construction noted, the floor supports under the old library are not up to today's standards and a new support structure will have to be installed. As with all renovations of old buildings, we can expect to find surprises along the way. Reminder:

Currently, there are two ways to enter the sanctuary, either through the front doors or through the north door (the door near the lectern). The door near the lectern is also the way to exit the sanctuary to the nearest restrooms located on the balcony above Fellowship Hall. Please remember that all children elementary age and younger must be accompanied by an adult when leaving the sanctuary. This is a safety issue, and it is very important that we keep our children safe.

We appreciate how cooperative everyone has been during this phase of the renovation, and we realize that there will be more changes to come that will require everyone's gracious flexibility.
