

Construction Update (2016-01-03)

**With all of the closures in and around the church, please pay attention to the signs that warn us not to enter the affected areas. These signs have been installed to maintain our safety, so do not go into any of these areas.**

The relentless rains that we experienced over the Christmas holidays will have an impact on the outdoor construction. We will need several days of dry weather before footers can be poured. Our construction team is ready to begin work as soon as conditions are favorable. Concrete block and sand will be delivered this week and work will begin on the elevator shaft for the State Street elevator next Monday.

While Parents Day Out has been off for the holidays, the mechanical subcontractor has been busy with the rough-in of the HVAC piping through the children's area. Rain has not impacted this work and it is on schedule to be completed before the children return after the first of the year.

### **Reminder:**

Currently, there are two ways to enter the sanctuary, either through the front doors or through the north door (the door near the lectern). The door near the lectern is also the way to exit the sanctuary to the nearest restrooms located on the balcony above Fellowship Hall. Please remember that all children elementary age and younger must be accompanied by an adult when leaving the sanctuary. This is a safety issue, and it is very important that we keep our children safe.
