

Construction Update (2016-01-17)

With all of the closures in and around the church, please pay attention to the signs that warn us not to enter the affected areas. These signs have been installed to maintain our safety, so do not go into any of these areas.

Since the rain has stopped and the weather has improved greatly, the masonry work on the elevator shaft is ongoing and many of the footers have been poured on the new State Street entrance. Progress continues on the interior construction and the boiler has been reattached so that temporary heaters are no longer necessary in the sanctuary. Work continues on the renovation of the organ and Mark Pace, our new organist/choirmaster, has traveled to New Market to observe the work that has been done to date.

Reminder:

Currently, there are two ways to enter the sanctuary, either through the front doors or through the north door (the door near the lectern). The door near the lectern is also the way to exit the sanctuary to the nearest restrooms located on the balcony above Fellowship Hall. Please remember that all children elementary age and younger must be accompanied by an adult when leaving the sanctuary. This is a safety issue, and it is very important that we keep our children safe.

We appreciate how cooperative everyone has been during this phase of the renovation, and we realize that there will be more changes to come that will require everyone's gracious flexibility.
