TRACK 1:

Beth Moore's, "DAVID: Seeking a Heart Like His"

David: Seeking a Heart Like His explores the life of David from shepherd boy to king. David's life serves both as a good and a bad example for modern-day Christians. Beth draws spiritual insight and understanding from a man who slew a giant and saved a kingdom. First released in 1996 as A Heart Like His, Beth Moore has updated her study on the life of David. We will meet for 11 weeks, beginning August 16th. If you've ever experienced doubts, temptations, inconsistencies, losses, or anguish over family problems, join Beth Moore on an exciting and intimate journey to know King David, the man after God's own heart.

TRACK 2:

Grant Standefer--Do You Know the Way? (August) The earliest description of the church of Jesus Christ is that we are the "People of the Way." What does that "way" look like in 21st century Knoxville? Grant Standefer, Executive Director of Compassion Coalition (a non-profit linking Knoxville churches in compassionate outreach) will be with us to look at trends and hopes for the church. Be a part of finding the way!

Meredith Loftis-100 Things Every Child Should Know before Confirmation (September through November) Join pastors Meredith and William as we explore the fundamentals of our faith and consider the importance of biblical literacy and our Reformed history. We will look at nearly 100 essential topics including key Bible stories, church history, sacraments, creeds, worship practices, world religions, and more. This is a great study to help refresh your memory and perhaps even learn something new. It is also a great opportunity to help you ensure your children are learning the basics of Christianity.
