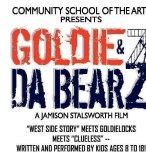

## Peninsula Club Directions:

**I-40 E.** -- Take Papermill Road exit & get in Northshore lanes. Go through traffic light onto Northshore Drive. Go across Kinston Pike and straight through the lights at Baum Drive and at the Northshore/Westland/Lyons View intersection. Turn left onto Lyons Bend Road (at Westminister Presbyterian Church). Follow this curvy road for 1.9 miles. Turn left onto Houser Road. The club is .8 mile on the left, just past Harrison Keepe subdivision.

**I-40W** – Take the Papermill Road exit. Turn left at the light at the end of the ramp. Turn left onto Northshore Drive. Follow directions from above from here.

**Pellissippi** – Exit Northshore Drive. Head east towards the Rocky Hill area. Go through Rocky Hill (Pilot, Weigals, Butler & Bailey, etc.). Take a right onto Lyons Bend Road (just past Westminister Church), and follow directions from above.
