but we proclaim Christ crucified; (I Cor. 1:22-23) God has put all things under the Lordship of Jesus Christ and has made Christ Head of the Church, which is his body. (Book of Order, G-1.0100) Jesus said, "If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me." For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake, and for the sake of the gospel,

will save it. (Mark 8:34-36) For the message about the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. (I Cor. 1:18)


